2. Complete 60 hours of relevant continuing education (CE), **or** provide documentary evidence of a relevant professional qualification and submit a case study, **or** submit materials demonstrating track record and contributions to the profession (for those with substantial experience)
3. Send your application fee and information for review by the ATTP review committee. Quarterly review dates are published on our website.
